

Contractor shall not assign nor permit employees to perform work on Purchaser's premises, and Contractor's employees shall not have access to Purchaser's premises except in the following circumstances:

- Purchaser invites Contractor's employees and issues them one-day badges to attend occasional onsite work product review meetings with Purchaser's representatives; or
- Contractor's unapplied leaders attend onsite meetings with Purchaser's leaders to discuss contract and program administration and/or new business proposals, or
- Contingent workers subject to Purchaser's 12-month rule and other restrictions on the use of contingent workers, or
- Employees of contractors that provide onsite services separate and distinct from Purchaser's normal products and services,
- Other exceptions that satisfy the business needs of the Purchaser
