JUN 2009 Additional Security Provision

Seller and Seller's subcontractors will sanitize all correspondence, invoices, purchase requests, etc... to remove the relation of the project name and Prime Contract number. If this subcontract involves access to a military installation, Seller may be required to comply with additional security requirements.

JUN 2009 Contractor Identification

(a) Contractor personnel and their subcontractors must identify themselves as Contractors or subcontractors during meetings, telephone conversations, in electronic messages, or correspondence related to this contract.

(b) Contractor-occupied facilities (on AFM C or other Government installations) such as offices, separate rooms, or cubicles must be clearly identified with Contractor supplied signs, name plates or other identification, showing that these are work areas for Contractor or subcontractor personnel.

Contractor Manpower reporting (CMR)

Seller shall report contracted labor hours required for performance of service provided under this contract to the DOD Enterprise-wide Contractor Manpower Reporting Application site (hereinafter eCMRA), at <http://www.ecmra.mil>. Seller is required to completely fill in all required data fields.

Contracted services excluded from reporting are based on Product Service Codes (PSCs). The excluded PSCs are:

(1) W, Lease/Rental of Equipment;

(2) X, Lease/Rental of Facilities;

(3) Y, Construction of Structures and Facilities;

(4) D, Automatic Data Processing and Telecommunications, IT and Telecom-Telecommunications Transmission (D304) and Internet (D322) ONLY;

(5) S, Utilities ONLY;

(6) V, Freight and Shipping ONLY.

Reporting inputs will be for the labor hours executed during the period of performance for each government fiscal year (FY), which runs 1 October through 30 September. While inputs may be recorded anytime during the FY, all data shall be reported no later than 31 October of each calendar year. Seller may direct questions to the CMRA help desk accessible via eCMRA.

Seller is required to flow this clause down to subcontractors at all tiers and identify and include Buyer's customer contract number (identified in the Customer Contracts Requirements document) in the flowdown.
